Math Grading Policy

Your grade will consist of the following categories and will break down as follows:

Tests/Quizzes 65% Homework 20% Benchmarks 10%

Math Facts 5%


Tests are usually at the end of a chapter although some chapters will be broken down further. Students are told about upcoming test as least a few days in advance. The best way to prepare for a test is to work practice problems at the end of the chapter.

Quizzes usually cover a couple of sections - sometimes these are announced and sometimes they are unannounced.

Homework is assigned regularly. Students will be give a 100 point grade based on homework completion. Each time a students misses an assignment, 5 points will be deducted from the 100. Sometimes homework is graded for accuracy and those will show up as separate homework grades. All work must be shown in order for students to receive any credit.

Benchmarks are quizzes over a specific standard we feel is important for you child to master before going to the next level of math. These may be retaken either as a whole class or individually if the student needs additional attempts to master the material.

Math Facts are timed tests over basic math facts involving integers. These are one step operations such as adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. They may retake these math facts tests as often as needed in order to master(pass).



Extra Help

If you feel the need for extra help, it is available. WE have a time period called success period - Tuesday and Thursday from 7:20 - 7:50. We also have success clini, - Tuesday, and Thursday from 3:00 - 4:00 (This will start after Labor Day). A student may also ask to visit another teacher during STudy Period - this is after REading at 12:00.
